CULTURE

- Shared values, behaviours, beliefs, how we treat one another, attitude
- What makes us unique
- What attracts and engages people

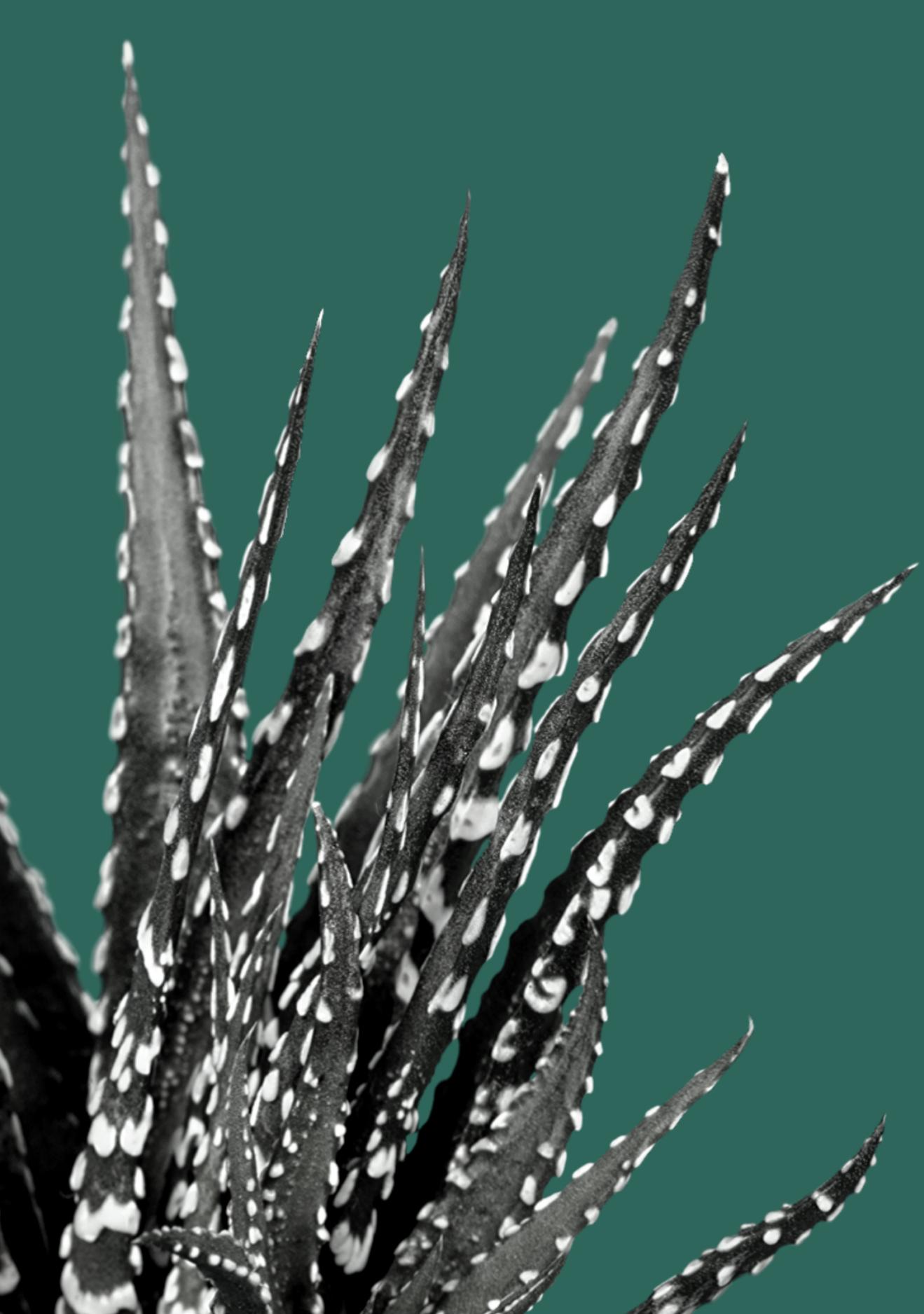

COMMON PURPOSE

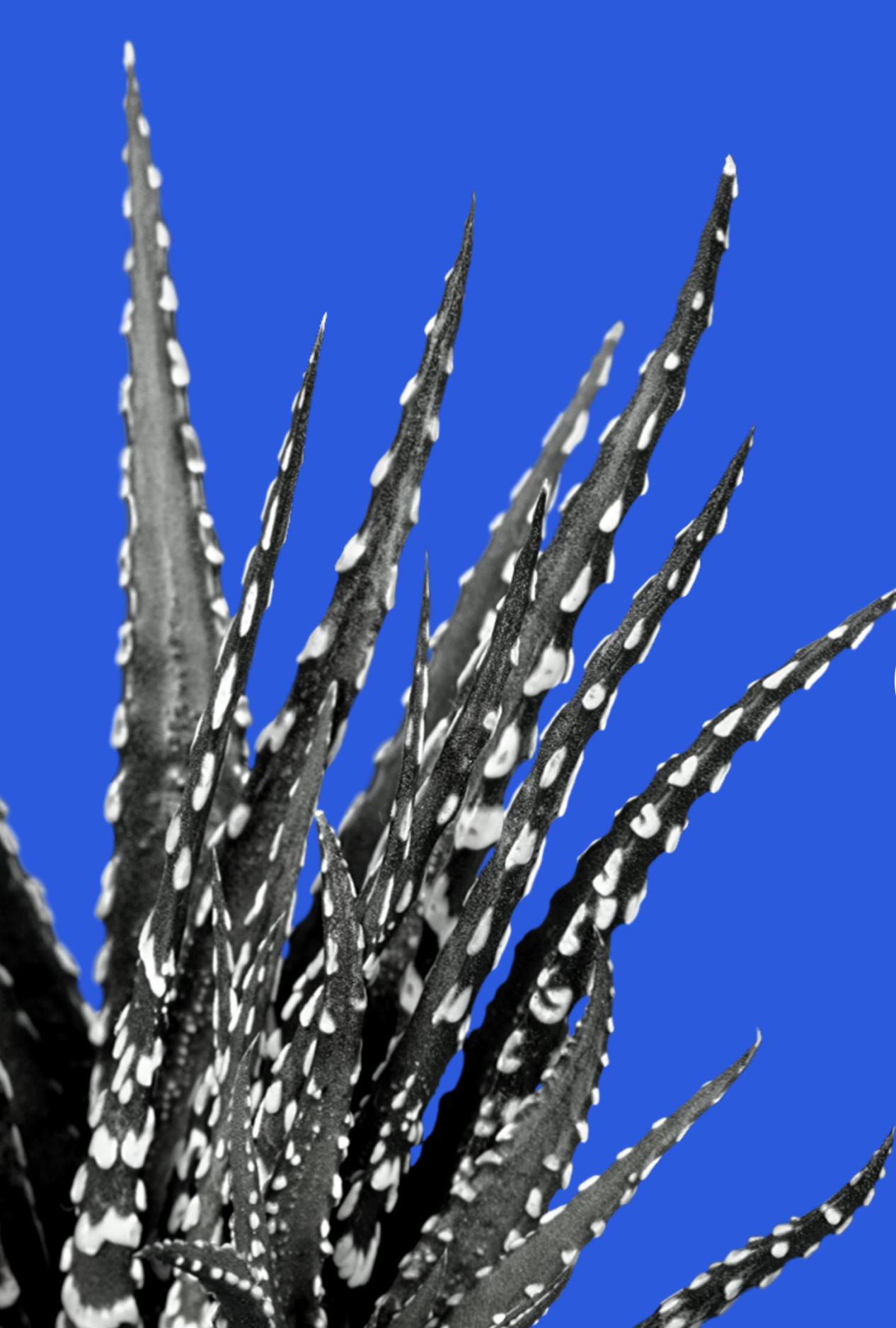

VULNERABILITY

- Job postings
- Our leadership development program
- Our orientation and training
- No dress code
- Bias training

COMMON PURPOSE

- Every chance we get we promote values
- We help people understand our shared goals and their role in achieving them
- We set the ground rules on how we treat one another

Building Inclusive Community

EMPOWER YOUR PEOPLE

- Create avenues for two-way communication and feedback
- Encourage (and sometimes beg for) input, suggestions, and feedback
- Create opportunities for people to come together to share and guide their experience
 - Social committee
 - Women of Tacofino
 - Newsletter - TacoTimes
- Regular surveys

EVALUATE YOUR VALUES

1

- **What are your values?**
- **Is there a people statement that mentions diversity and inclusion?**
- **Ask yourself why**

- **Promote in your recruitment/onboarding**
- **Turn your leaders into champions**
- **Celebrate behaviours**
 - **Provide open praise**
 - **Reward in your incentive programs**

BRING THEM TO LIFE

- **Help people understand bias**
- **Make curiosity the default**

BRING THEM TO LIFE

2

Involve your people in building community

- Create avenues where people can share their ideas and experience
 - Ask for feedback and act on it
 - Have a dedicated email for ideas
 - Support your people in coming together in groups

3. Hold People Accountable

COMMUNICATE CLEARLY

- Make sure there is zero ambiguity
- Help people understand during the onboarding process

MAKE EMPLOYMENT DECISIONS ON THEM

- Support and grow your champions
- Squash toxic behaviour...quickly

Check your own decisions

- Hold yourself as accountable as you would others

4. *Measure*

Create a survey

Survey

Distribute to understand your current climate

Benchmark

Distribute every 6 months thereafter

Regularly distribute

Share findings with leadership team and adjust based on opportunity

Compare and Adjust

Make it simple!

Have questions around diversity and inclusion

Break it down and present to your executive and leadership teams

Create goals based off of them
